

- 7. Indian will review and process all warranty claims within the month after receipt from the distributor.
- 8. If a claim requires a claimed parts evaluation by Indian, then Indian will request the parts from the distributor before approving the warranty claims.
- 9. The distributor will hold all tagged warranty parts for Indian's inspection for a period of six months after date of claim.
- 10. In the event a distributor is unable to approve or disapprove a warranty, then the distributor will forward the claim form and parts to Indian for approval and the distributor will notify the dealer of his action and of the delay in the processing of the claim.
- 11. Payment to the distributor for approved warranty claims (parts at distributor cost), will be made to the distributor through a credit being issued to the distributor's account with Indian.
- 12. The Indian Motorcycle Company reserves the right of being the final arbiter as to the existence of a defect in material or workmanship and whether the parts are warranteed.
