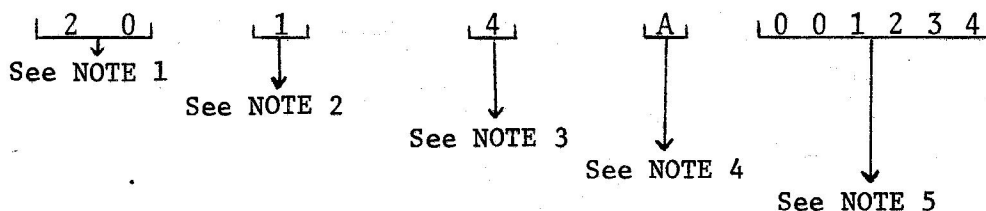

ALL "M" SERIES MOTORCYCLES - SERIAL NUMBERS

Beginning June, 1974, all "M" Series motorcycles will have a new serial numbering system. This system will aid you in properly identifying and ordering parts for your customers' motorcycles.

A typical number will look like this:



NOTE 1: The first two numbers contain the model of the motorcycle. The model numbers are as follows:

13 = MX-76B (75cc)	23 = ML-100
15 = MX-80	30 = ME-125
16 = MX-74B (75cc)	
20 = ME-100A	
22 = MT-100	

NOTE 2: The third number (the phase number) will be used whenever a new designed part is used on the motorcycle.

NOTE 3: The year of production will be the fourth number. One number only:

4 = 1974
5 = 1975
6 = 1976, etc.
