BREAK-IN PROCEDURE

Your Indian Motorcycle is manufactured to precise tolerances. Therefore careful break-in procedures must be followed to insure trouble free service and operation.

During the first five hours of operation, care should be taken not to submit the engine to undue stresses. Power should be applied gradually through use of the throttle allowing the engine to come up in rpm gradually, no more than half throttle opening is recommended during this period.
